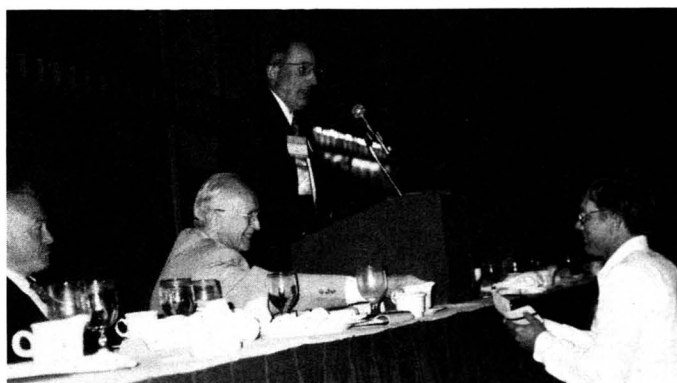


Bovine "Give-Away"
